Conflict Minerals Position

Notwithstanding any information provided by TURCK Inc. on its Website or other communications concerning the substance content of its products, this document represents our knowledge and belief as of the date that it is provided.

TURCK Inc. is committed to ensuring the safety, health, and protection of people and the environment. Per section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act for Conflict Minerals, publicly traded companies in the United States are required to disclose their use of conflict minerals in their products. As TURCK Inc. is a foreign owned company we are not required to disclose nor track the origin of our raw materials.

Due to the complexity of the routes by which metals, and in particular precious metals are smelted, recycled and sold, including the common practice of combining ores and scrap from many different sources, it is often impossible for any company to obtain full traceability to an exact origin of all the materials referenced in the Dodd-Frank Act.

Turck manufactured products and including those manufactured by Turck subsidiaries and business partners, do not to the best of our knowledge contain minerals that were mined in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or an adjoining country.
